Art Editor Responsibilities

- Recruit committee of ASU students able to demonstrate an interest in art and literature to aid in submission solicitation and evaluation
- Organize art submissions and scores in a timely manner
- Seek a faculty member to advise the art committee and to discuss committee structure, including submission solicitation, evaluation and voting methods
- Establish a regular meeting time with committee members and faculty adviser to review and score all submissions in a consistent manner
- Devise submission solicitation plans for committee
- Write submission critiques when necessary
- Notify students of acceptance and rejection
- Ensure the published magazine editions are error-free, particularly in the art section
- Attend editorial board meeting weekly
- Serve a minimum of one office hour weekly
- Attend all The Peel events

- Must have extensive experience in art and leadership
